Science in Action

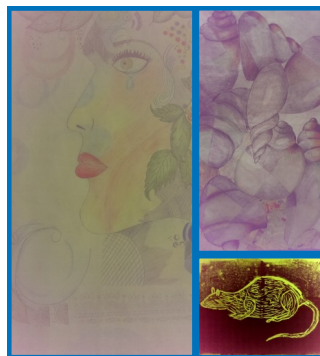
As part of their Science lessons, Year 8 pupils have been interactively studying the Solar System.
